

NOTICE BY GRANITE COUNTY OF A PUBLIC HEARING ON DECEMBER 18, 2018

Notice is given by the Board of Granite County Commissioners that the Board will hold a public hearing at 1:30 pm local time on December 18, 2018 regarding the **Petitions to Establish Portions of Lucky Lane and Hilltop Lane as County Roads**. The Petitions request that county roads be established for the first 580 feet of Lucky Lane and also the first 280 feet of Hilltop Lane after intersecting Lucky Lane, located in Section 24, Township 5 North, Range 14 West, Denton's Tracts, Granite County. This public hearing on the Petitions will be held at the Georgetown Lake Volunteer Fire Department's Fire Hall, 100 Fire Lane, Anaconda, MT 59711, being open to the public.
